It is one of the most polluted places in the world, but hope remains.

The Niger Delta in Nigeria is a perfect illustration of the 'oil curse': decades of oil exploitation and repeated oil spills, coupled with clandestine oil trafficking, have devastated the region's mangroves, a source of life essential to ocean biodiversity, climate stability, and the survival of local communities.

However, individuals are taking action to fight against this environmental and health disaster.
